

URS MORONG HISTORY

CONVERGING SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND EDUCATION

Batas Pambansa Blg. 469 was approved, June 10, 1983, converting Morong National Comprehensive School into a technological and polytechnic institute, thus Rizal Technological and Polytechnic Institute (RTPI) was born with the underlying philosophy of pursuing development education in basic and tertiary levels.

Dr. Olivia F. De Leon, an alumna of the Institute, was designated June 6, 1994 by DECS Secretary Armand Fabella as Officer In-Charge of the Institute which marks the call for the basic R's – Reawakening, Retooling, Reengineering, Rethinking, Redevelopment and Reconciliation of the entire RTPI community.

House Bill 9300 authored co-authored by Congressman Emigdio S. Tanjuatco Jr. and Gilberto M. Duavit respectively, was enacted on March 1, 1995 into law through R.A. 7933, an act converting Rizal Technological and Polytechnic Institute into a state college, to be known as Rizal Polytechnic College envisioned to be the center of excellence for human resource development in academic and technological disciplines.

March 14, 1996 President Fidel V. Ramos appointed Dr. Olivia F. De Leon as the first President of the Rizal Polytechnic College.

Republic Act 9157, on August 11, 2001 established the University of Rizal System with RPC as one of its ten campuses, which is now named as URS Morong campus. Atty. Lilia S. Garcia became the transition President while Dr. Olivia F. De Leon was appointed as the first University President.

Dr. Marita R. Canapi, the second University President, took her oath-of-office February 6, 2012 and had her first day of service to the University on February 23, 2012.
