HISTORY OF URS TANAY

University of Rizal System Tanay was originally established as Rizal National Agricultural School (RNAS) and approved on June 16, 1956 by virtue of Republic Act 1560, authored by Cong. Serafin Salvador. RNAS opened on May 27, 1959 offering secondary level with vocational agriculture for male and homemaking curriculum for female. It was chartered as a state college on June 24, 1983 thru Batas Pambansa Bilang 622 authored by Assemblyman Frisco F. San Juan making it as the first state college in the Province of Rizal known as Rizal College of Agriculture and Technology (RCAT). RCAT was later renamed Rizal State College (RSC) by virtue of Republic Act 7858 sponsored by Hon. Congressman Emigdio S. Tanjuatco, Jr. and approved by then President Fidel V. Ramos on January 21, 1995. The passage of Republic Act 9157 on June 7, 2001 which lapsed into law on August 11, 2001 established the University of Rizal System (URS) by integrating the Rizal State College, the Rizal Polytechnic College, and Rizal Technological University-Antipolo Annex. On June 18, 2002, Tanay Campus was identified as the main campus of the University thru CHED Resolution No. 411-2002.

Its conversion as a state college brought about very significant changes, including among which, the expansion of curricular offerings. It had provided and served as the center for development on agricultural, technological, professional, and occupational training and exercise three-fold functions of instruction, research and extension, and the development of appropriate technologies on community-based enterprises.

The campus' flagship program is agriculture. It likewise offers complete education from Kindergarten to Graduate School. The Campus offers academic programs in the doctorate and masters aligned to agriculture, baccalaureate that offers courses in education, arts, sciences, agribusiness and agriculture and non-degree courses. Likewise, the programs are of Level II, Level III reaccredited status and on its first phase for Level IV accreditation. Today, URS Tanay is proud of its 170 capable and efficient personnel from the faculty and support staff. From its humble beginning of 93 students in 1959, the population has grown to 2,161 at present.

At present the campus also has the state-of-the-art laboratory and building for Research and the Sustainable Agriculture and Natural Resources Institute (SANRI). The campus is also an advocate of the environment being the center for environmental education and biodiversity research.
