Section III. Bid Data Sheet

General Foreman	Must be TESDA Certified or possess certification/training from a recognized construction training or accrediting institution relevant to construction supervision or trade works. Must have at least three (3) years of relevant experience as General Foreman or equivalent supervisory position in building or infrastructure construction projects. Provide direct supervision and coordination of daily construction activities to ensure works are executed in accordance with approved plans, specifications, and construction schedule.
Materials Engineer I	Must be a licensed Civil Engineer with valid PRC license and duly accredited by DPWH as Materials Engineer I. Must have at least three (3) years of relevant experience in construction materials testing, quality control, and inspection for building or infrastructure projects. Responsible for the conduct, supervision, and evaluation of all required materials testing for the project to ensure compliance with approved plans, specifications, and applicable standards. Prepare and implement the Quality Control and Materials Testing Program covering civil, structural, and related construction works.

25.3 (b)(i)	<p>The quality component shall be assessed on the basis of criteria with corresponding numerical weights, which may include qualitative, environmental, or social aspects linked to the subject matter of the contract. These may include any or a combination of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Quality and technical merit, including technical competence and a credible track record; b) Aesthetic and functional design and characteristics; c) Approach and methodology; d) Accessibility; e) Tools and equipment; f) Social, environmental, economic, and innovative characteristics; g) Organization, qualification, and experience of employees or staff assigned to perform the contract; h) Ongoing contracts and work commitments; i) After-sales service and technical assistance; j) Delivery conditions, such as delivery period and delivery process; k) Disposal measures; or l) Other relevant criteria in relation to the subject Goods or Infrastructure Projects to be procured. 	<p><i>“not applicable”</i></p>
