## MIBF: Book without Borders

URSP College Deans and Program heads along with the Campus Librarian actively participated in the Manila International Book Fair last September 18, 2014 at the Mall of Asia Complex in Pasay City.

Manila International Book Fair (MIBF) is the biggest, longest-

running, most prestigious and internationally-recognized book event in the Philippines.

It is an annual celebration where bookworms and enthusiast gather to participate to various activities the fair offers.

With over a hundred exhibitors and publishers, it's a veritable feast for even the most voracious reader out there.

URSP representatives selected books that they found useful to students and faculty as well.

## E-LEARNING CENTER ESTABLISHED

With the advancement of technology, the library needs to adapt with the current trend in information services.

To provide the researchers additional access to on-line resources other than print,

the library has established an Electronic Resource Center, equipped with 14 terminals, 5 units are intended for internet searching/encoding, 7 units for STARBOOKS, a DOST database and 1 unit for the KOHA, an on-line database

of the library collection; a separate unit is intended for faculty use.

Aside from the terminals provided, wireless connection is also made available.

Librarians and Librarian-in-Charge of the 10 URS Campuses along with MIS representatives and administrative officials attended the launching and training for Science Technology Academic and Research Based Openly Operated Kiosk (STARBOOKS) last April 3, 2014 at the Gusaling Sibol

A part of this, DOST-STII has granted URSP with STARBOOKS program installation last September 2014. STARBOOKS or Science and Technology Academic and Research

-Based-Openly-Operated Kiosk Station is the Philippines' first digital Science Library is intended to serve as information access portals in the key areas in the Philippines. It contains digitized Science and Technology resources in various formats (text/ and video/ audio)

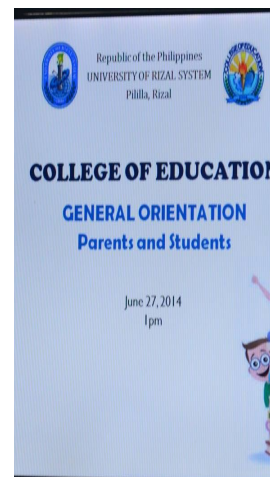
## LIBRARY ORIENTATION HELD

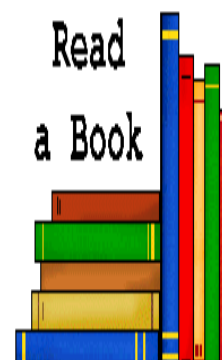

### Organization

Whether you're researching or just trying to keep tabs on your favorite sites, it can be hard to manage the wealth of resources the web offers. These tools can help you keep all of your data organized and easy to find.

Bubbl.us: Use this mind mapping tool to get your thoughts in order.

Dropbox: Store files, resources, photos, and more on the web and access them from anywhere using this free (up to a point) service.

Evernote: Evernote makes it easy to clip interesting articles from the web, store them, and organize them to look through later.

Google Reader: Google Reader makes it simple to access your favorite blogs and RSS feeds from one place.

Memonic: With Memonic, you can take notes, clip, or highlight any web content of interest, take it with you, and share it with others.

MindMeister: Another great mind map, MindMeister will ensure you can always keep your brainstorming resources on hand.

NetVibes: Use Netvibes as your go-to page for collecting RSS feeds that meet your research needs.

Zotero: Use this handy extension to collect, manage, and cite your research sources right from your browser.

### Bookmarking

These tools can help you keep up with great resources and reference sites.

BlinkList: With Blinklist, you can bookmark your favorite sites online and save a copy offline for sharing or backing up your research.

Clipboard: Clip out important pieces of the web using this neat app.

Delicious: Use Delicious to organize your bookmarks online, and access them easily with tags.

Diigo: Diigo makes it easy to highlight, clip, and add sticky-notes right on a web page.

Pinterest: Pinterest is a great way to visually bookmark things that interest you.

### Notes and Markup

You don't need a notebook or a highlighter to take notes and study these days. Use these tools to keep notes and edit sites right from the web.

A.nnotate: This resource makes it easy to keep notes about your online research organized, as they can be written right on top of the content of any site you choose.

Bounce: You can make notes, share feedback, and share any web resource with friends using Bounce.

Highlighter: If you're using Firefox, this add-on makes it possible to highlight any page.

Internote: Also for Firefox is Internote, a great sticky note application that lets you add notes to any webpage.

**Note Anywhere:** Chrome users can try out Note Anywhere, an extension that makes it possible to leave sticky notes, lists, and other memos anywhere you'd like.

### Citation

These tools make it easy to ensure you're citing things correctly.

**BibMe:** Enter books, websites, journals, and other sources into this tool, and it will automatically create a bibliography for you. Even better, you can even choose between different formats.

**EasyBib:** Get a free trial of this site to build a bibliography in APA, Chicago, or MLA style.

**Son of Citation Machine:** Grab the ISBN number off of a book and this site will feed you back an MLA or APA citation for it.

### Social

Share research, writing, data, and more through these great social sites.

**99 Polls:** Do your own data collection using this site that allows you to post a poll to a website, blog, social network, or anywhere else you'd like.

**CiteULike:** CiteULike is a great way to store your own scholarly research and take advantage of things that others have found as well.

**ConceptShare:** If you're working on a group project, this tool is great for collaboration, even over long distances.

**Confolio:** Confolio enables users to store files, links, and ideas and to share those resources with others for collaborative work.

**CampusBug:** This cool community has loads of useful tools, like flashcards, a bibliography generator, rapid learning, and a question bank.

**Mendeley:** Mendeley is both a research tool and an academic social network. Visitors to the site can generate bibliographies, import papers, and get suggestions for research as well as collaborate and meet other academics and students online.

**NoteMesh:** Using NoteMesh, you can share your notes with classmates whether they're right next to you in class or on the other side of the world.

**Skype:** Skype is a great way for info junkies, students, and researchers to keep in touch with others or even interview for a job. [Google Hangouts](#) is another option, even offering courses and meetups that can be quite educational.

**SpeakLike:** Forget about language barriers; use this chat application that will translate between two languages simultaneously.
